April Stanford, 10, patient brought by parents at 10 years old, has been instrumental to these tests. Subject shows long term healthy coping mechanisms for chemically induced comas and sleep. Breathing has remained normal, save for the occasional bad dream. Vitals have looked normal, tests conclude everything going according to plan.

Maverik Adams, 18, was brought in as a part of a 'study abroad' program. Maverik was covertly put to sleep and the Company continues to monitor him. Vitals look off--as if in a permanent state of panic, never quite catching his breath. It is surmised that these are side effects due to the use of Trichloromethane upon acquiring subject.

Xander Oahul, 10, was surrendered to the company as a part of an adoption program contract with the state of Florida. Xander, made it the least amount of time with us, and passed away earlier this year while asleep and awaiting waking procedures from Dr. Jeemann. Xander's last known guardians were made aware and a funeral is scheduled later this month. Vitals were always poor, heart rate too high, blood pressure too low.

Alexis Johann, 3, was a "parental donation" as part of a now retired campaign. Alexis has never known anything but her sleepstate, and vitals look good. She is acclimated to her state and nothing has ever worried staff about her experience. FFLCA levels are low, but with time, this can improve. Administering serums has proven to work well for Alexis, and her success is all but guaranteed.

Jackson Stevenson, 6. Nothing is understood of this patient's background, but subject shows promise during this test. Of all subjects, dreamstate seems enhanced, TCRU and FFLCA levels look fine, and ultimately, subject seems to be experiencing dreamstate with above average results. Vitals have been nothing short of phenomenal.

Ryan REDACTED, 5, patient was acquired from REDACTED INFORMATION after struggles with REDACTED, and difficulties surrounding REDACTED INFORMATION-REDACTED INFORMATION. Vitals are not good, and we suspect interference by REDACTED INFORMATION. Monitors are on high alert and we continue to monitor vitals attentively and with great concern. Sleepstate and dreamstate has been disrupted several times, and pain neurotransmitters have been seen to be active quite often.
